Katherine B. Forrest is a partner in Cravath's Litigation Department. She most recently served as a U.S. District Judge for the Southern District of New York and was the former Deputy Assistant Attorney General in the Antitrust Division of the U.S. Department of Justice. Over the course of her career, Ms. Forrest has been regarded as a leader in legal issues relating to technology, including the digital environment, big data and artificial intelligence. She regularly speaks on these issues and has a forthcoming book entitled *When Machines Can be Judge, Jury and Executioner: Artificial Intelligence and the Law*. Ms. Forrest is a regular technology columnist for the *New York Law Journal* ("NYLJ"), and she recently authored a chapter on emerging issues in copyright law and artificial intelligence in *The Law of Artificial Intelligence and Smart Machines*. Ms. Forrest received a B.A. with honors from Wesleyan University and a J.D. from NYU School of Law where she co-teaches a course on Quantitative Methods and the Law.
