The Practicing Law Institute (PLI) allows UCS attorneys to access to PLI programs at no charge.

UCS attorneys may register online at no cost for the following PLI programs:

- Live In-Person, Live Webcast, On-Demand

To access an existing PLI account to view PLI programs, UCS attorneys should

- Go to www.pli.edu
- Click "SIGN IN" (upper right corner)
- Enter your "BUSINESS EMAIL," (i.e., court email address) and "PASSWORD"
- Click "SIGN IN" (under "PASSWORD")
- If you have forgotten your password, you can reset it by clicking the "Forgot Password?" link and following the prompts and directions provided.
- Login to the PLI webpage again using the new password.

To create an PLI account, UCS attorneys should

- Go to www.pli.edu
- Click "SIGN IN" (upper right corner)
- Click "CREATE ACCOUNT"
- Enter your "BUSINESS EMAIL," (i.e., court email address) and follow the prompts and directions provided to create a password and sign in to the PLI webpage.
